



## Coronavirus Local Restrictions Support Grant

Last updated Monday 2 November 2020

The Local Restrictions Support Grant (LRSB) supports businesses that were operating as normal from their business premises but have had to close for at least 2 weeks due to either local or national lockdown restrictions put in place by the government. The grant is specifically for businesses that pay business rates on their premises.

### Who is eligible?

You may be eligible if your business:

- Occupies a property which pays business rates
- Is in a local lockdown area and have been required to close as a result of the local restrictions.
- Has been required to close for at least a 2 week period due to the restrictions
- Is / has been unable to provide their usual face to face customer service from their premises

### What you will receive

Each grant will be based on the rateable value of your property on the first full day of the lockdown restrictions as per the table below:

Rateable value of premises	Grant payment per 2 weeks	Grant payment per 4 weeks
£15,000 or under	£667	£1334
£15,001 to £50,999	£1000	£2000
£51,000 or over	£1500	£3000
