Will you be wanting to submit declarations yourself?	Do you have a "Badge(s)" from the Community Service Providers ("CSP"s) to access their systems and file the submissions at the ports/airports that you will bring goods into?	
	Do you have a badge to link to HMRC's CHIEF (or CDS) systems?	
	Do you have third party software to link the CSPs and CHIEF/CDS?	
	Will you be using "Roll On/Roll Off" ("RoRo") ports e.g. Dover, Channel Tunnel?	
	If using the RoRo ports, have you checked whether they require pre-lodgement or temporary storage entries?	
Will you be using an agent?	Have you checked that the agent has capacity to do the work? Some agents are unable or unwilling to take on new business because they do not have the capacity to do the work	
Do you want to take advantage of the simplified procedures from 1 January 2021 to 30 June 2021 (basic entries on import, deferring VAT and Duty for 6 months etc.)?	Do you have a duty deferment account or have you been approved for Simplified Import VAT Accounting ("SIVA")	
	Are you moving controlled goods?	
	Are any of your goods subject to excise duty?	
	☐ Is your agent able to act for you for these procedures? (Some	



	may not be able to do these in their normal capacity as agent)	
Are you ready for the new customs procedures from 1 January 2021?	Have you checked that you will be able to receive the C79 certificate/statement of VAT paid/due at import or that your agent/you can access it via HMRC's systems?	
	Do you know what commodity codes are required for your goods, the duty rates for them and whether there are any special licences required?	
	Do you know the origin of all your goods (e.g. 100% EU, 75%+ EU, other country origin)?	
	Do you know if there are any preferences, countervailing or anti- dumping duties for goods that are not of 75%+ EU origin?	
	Do you wish to use inward/outward processing/end use reliefs or Customs warehousing duty suspension regimes?	
	Are you approved to use any of these in the UK? You may be approved for the EU at the moment, but will need to apply separately for the UK as things stand;	
	Do you know if there are any UK labelling, safety standards, regulatory issues in the UK for your goods?	
	What are your Inco/shipping terms? Do these need amending to reflect that the UK is a separate Customs union?	
	Do you know who is responsible for making the declaration, paying the VAT and duty under the shipping terms?	

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
